## Sports premium grant expenditure: Report to governors: 2016/17

### Overview of the school

#### Number of pupils and sports premium grant received

Total number of pupils on roll	38
Total number of pupils eligible for sports premium	30
Amount of sports premium received per pupil £5	150
<b>Total amount of sports premium received</b>	<b>£8150</b>

Funding has been provided by the government to increase children's participation in sports.

At Henry Prince we are:-

- Working with Castele Consultancy to allow the pupils participate in a variety of sporting events (£450 x 3 = £1350)
- Providing high quality CPD for staff, supply cover (£600)
- Providing swimming lesson for Years 2, 3 and 4. (£1420 plus staffing £500)
- Provided support for Sports Day activities (£600)
- Provide appropriate facilities for sporting activities, including Glow in the Dark Day (£700)
- Provide cover to enable outdoor education trip (£400 plus £240 plus £227)
- Provided valuable transition activities for our pupils to engage with pupils who will attend the middle school with them (107)
- Purchase of new equipment (£450)
- Developed pupils' knowledge of healthy life styles and encouraged a want to engage in life-long participation in physical activity and sport. (after school club £1590)

Total so far = £8184

Observations have been recorded of lunchtime and during lessons as well as comments made by visitors in school that support this view.

As a result, pupils have raised self-esteem raised emotional well-being, improved behaviour, supported our good attendance record, enhanced parental engagement, a number of pupils attend outside clubs and activities. Pupils arrange games activities during play times lead by young leaders.
