Summary of PPG spending 2016/17

Objectives in spending PPG:

- To increase the proportion of pupils achieving age-related expectations in Reading, Writing and Mathematics
- To increase the proportion of pupils exceeding age-related expectations in Reading, Writing and Mathematics
- To further increase the proportion of children making better than expected progress in Reading
- To increase the proportion of children making better than expected progress in Reading, Writing and Mathematics
- To raise the self-esteem and confidence of target pupils and support them with dealing with their emotions and forming positive relationships with their peers
- To ensure that all pupils have access to school visits to enrich their curriculum and remove the potential cost barrier
- To train staff in specific area of need.

Summary of spending and actions taken:

- £1200 to employ a teaching assistant for 1:1 and small group support
- £500 targeted 1:1
- £250 educational Visits and visitors
- £2036 music provision - extra cost
